'Trump White House adviser acted above law'

A White House adviser to President Donald Trump acted as if he were "above the law" when he refused to cooperate with a congressional investigation into the Jan. 6, 2021, attack on the U.S. Capitol, prosecutors argued at his trial Wednesday.



Peter Navarro was charged with two counts of contempt of Congress, but his lawyer argued he didn't ignore the House Jan. 6 Committee. Instead, Navarro told members to contact Trump about what might be protected by executive privilege, the attorney said.

A judge has found the privilege argument alone isn't a defense against the charges because Navarro couldn't show evidence that the former Republican president had invoked it.

Both sides rested after committee staffers testified about sending the subpoena and Navarro's response. Closing arguments and jury deliberations are expected Thursday.

Navarro, a senior trade adviser, was subpoenaed in February 2022 by the House panel investigating how and

why a mob of Trump supporters stormed the U.S. Capitol and interrupted the certification of the presidential vote for Joe Biden, a Democrat. Navarro had promoted Trump's baseless claims of mass voter fraud, and the committee thought he might have more information about any connection those claims had to the attack, prosecutor John Crabb said.

But Navarro didn't hand over any emails, reports or notes. When the date came for him to testify before the committee, he didn't show up, Crabb said. Even if the president had invoked executive privilege, Navarro should have come before the committee, answered what questions he could and cited privilege when he couldn't answer, he said. "It wasn't voluntary. It wasn't an invitation. A subpoena is a legal requirement," Crabb said. "We are a nation of laws and our system doesn't work if

people believe they are above the law."

Defense attorney Stanley Woodward told the jury that Navarro did get in touch with committee staffers, but asked them to talk to Trump to see what information the president intended to be protected by executive privilege. That never happened, he said.

"The evidence in this case will not show that Dr. Navarro was willful in his failure to comply," Woodward said. He pushed back on efforts to link Navarro closely with the Jan. 6 attack and said the prosecution's opening arguments were like a movie trailer that promises more than the show delivers: "It's like one of those movies where you get nothing after the preview," he said.

Navarro, a former economics professor, faces up to a year behind bars if convicted. He is the second Trump aide to face criminal charges after refusing to cooperate with the House committee. White House adviser Steve Bannon also made an executive privilege argument but was convicted of two counts of contempt of Congress and sentenced to four months behind bars.

Will pardon all peaceful January 6 protesters: Vivek

Republican presidential candidate Vivek Ramaswamy has vowed that he will pardon all peaceful January 6 protesters if he gets elected as the next US president in 2024.

The 38-year-old Indian American entrepreneur has gained traction after he denounced the US Justice Department for its "political persecution" of non-violent protesters at the Republican primary presidential debate last month.

"America now has a two-tiered justice system: Antifa and BLM rioters roam free while peaceful January 6 protesters are imprisoned without bail. Biden's 'Department of Injustice' has executed over 1,000 arrests for nonviolent offenses related to January 6, casting a dark shadow over Lady Justice and the foundational principles of our legal system," he said in a statement.

"To unify this country, I commit as president to pardon all Americans who were targets of politicised federal prosecutions and those denied due process. This includes all peaceful, nonviolent January 6 protesters who were denied their constitutional due process



rights," he said on Wednesday. The January 6 riot saw more than 2,000 people enter the US Capitol as lawmakers certified the results of the 2020 election, in which President Joe Biden defeated Donald Trump.

The mob stormed the Capitol following a speech from Trump, who was speaking at a rally not far from the Capitol grounds. In his speech, Trump claimed election fraud and called on then-Vice-President Mike Pence to overturn the results.

The riot led to the biggest police investigation in US history with hundreds of people accused of criminal offenses. Ramaswamy said he will end the weaponisation of police

power in America and noted that every Republican candidate must be clear on hard issues.

He said on Sunday that while he expects to become the party's nominee for the November 2024 US elections, he will vote for Trump if the former president secures the nomination.

He also expressed his intention to pardon Trump, who currently faces an array of legal challenges, should he be elected as President of the United States.

"If Donald Trump's the nominee — yes, I will support him, and if I'm the president, yes, I will pardon him because that will help reunite the country. But it's not the most important thing I'm going to do as the next president. It is the table stakes for moving this country forward," Ramaswamy told ABC news.

Following his impressive performance in the inaugural Republican primary presidential debate last month, Ramaswamy, an entrepreneur-turned-politician, has experienced a surge in popularity, competing alongside fellow Indian American rival Nikki Haley, the former Governor of South Carolina.

Prosecutors seeking new indictment for Hunter Biden

Federal prosecutors plan to ask a grand jury to indict President Joe Biden's son Hunter by the end of the month, according to court documents filed Wednesday.

The exact charges the president's son would face were not immediately clear, but appeared related to a gun possession charge in which he was accused of having a firearm while being a drug user. He has also been under investigation by federal prosecutors for his business dealings.

U.S. Attorney for Delaware David Weiss, newly named a special counsel in the case, referred to a seeking an indictment before Sept. 29 in a status report required by Judge Maryellen Moreika.

Defense attorneys have argued that an agreement sparing Hunter Biden from prosecution on a felony gun charge remains in place. It was part of a plea deal on misdemeanor tax offenses that fell apart during a court appearance in July.

Biden was charged in June with two misdemeanor crimes of failure to pay more than USD 100,000 in taxes from over USD 1.5 million in income in both 2017 and 2018.

Mexico ends federal ban on abortion, patchwork of state restrictions remains

A Mexican Supreme Court ruling that invalidated all federal criminal penalties for abortion continued a regional trend of widening access to the procedure but left in place a patchwork of varying state restrictions.

The high court ordered on Wednesday that abortion be removed from the federal penal code, and will require the federal public health service and all federal health institutions to offer abortion to anyone who requests it.

That will mean access for millions of Mexicans. The Social Security Service and other federal institutions provide health care to most people who work

in the formal economy.

"No woman or pregnant person, nor any health worker, will be able to be punished for abortion," the Information Group for Chosen Reproduction, known by its Spanish initials GIRE, said in a statement.

Abortions are not widely prosecuted as a crime, but many doctors refuse to provide them, citing the law.

Some 20 Mexican states, however, still criminalise abortion. Those laws were not affected by the Supreme Court ruling, but abortion rights advocates will likely ask state judges to follow its logic.

Celebration of the ruling soon spilled out onto social media.

"Today is a day of victory and justice for Mexican women!" Mexico's National Institute for Women wrote in a message on the social media platform X, formerly known as Twitter. The government organisation called the decision a "big step" toward gender equality.

Senator Olga Sanchez Cordero, a former Supreme Court justice, applauded the ruling, saying on X that it represented an advance toward "a more just society in which the rights of all are respected". She called on Mexico's Congress to pass legislation in response.

But others in the highly religious country decried the decision. Irma Barrientos, director of the Civil Association for the Rights of the Conceived, said



opponents will continue the fight against expanded abortion access.

"We're not going to stop," Barrientos said. "Let's remember what happened in the United States. After 40 years, the Supreme Court reversed its abortion decision, and we're

not going to stop until Mexico guarantees the right to life from the moment of conception."

The court said on X that "the legal system that criminalised abortion" in Mexican federal law was unconstitutional because it "violates the human rights of women and people with the ability to gestate".

The decision came two years after the court ruled that abortion was not a crime in one northern state. That ruling set off a slow state-by-state process of decriminalising it.

Last week, the central state of Aguascalientes became the 12th state to drop criminal penalties.

Abortion rights activists will have to continue seeking legalisation state by state, though

Wednesday's decision should make that easier. State legislatures can also act on their own to erase abortion penalties.

For now, the ruling does not mean that every Mexican woman will be able to access the procedure immediately, explained Fernanda Diaz de Leon, sub-director and legal expert for women's rights group IPAS.

What it does do - in theory - is obligate federal agencies to provide care to patients. That's likely to have a cascade of effects.

Diaz de Leon said removing the federal ban takes away another excuse used by care providers to deny abortions in states where the procedure is no longer a crime.

Myanmar scribe gets a 20-year sentence

A court in Myanmar sentenced a photojournalist for an underground news agency to 20 years in prison with hard labor for his coverage of a deadly May cyclone's aftermath, the media organisation said Wednesday.

The sentence given Sai Zaw

Thaika, a photographer for the independent online news service Myanmar Now, appeared to be the most severe for any journalist detained since the military overthrew the elected government of Aung San Suu Kyi in February 2021.

The press freedom group Reporters Without Borders said in April that Myanmar is the

world's second-biggest jailer of journalists, behind only China. The country ranks near the bottom of the group's 2023 World Press Freedom Index, placing 176th out of 180 countries.

Myanmar Now, which operates underground, reported that a military tribunal tried, convicted and sentenced Sai Zaw Thaika, 40, during the first

court hearing since he was detained in the western state of Rakhine.

The proceedings took place inside Insein prison in Yangon, Myanmar's biggest city, where the photographer was jailed after his arrest. The news agency said Sai Zaw Thaika was allowed no family visits and denied legal representation.

Japan launches rocket carrying X-ray telescope to explore origins of universe, lunar lander

Japan launched a rocket Thursday carrying an X-ray telescope that will explore the origins of the universe as well as a small lunar lander.

The launch of the HII-A rocket from Tanegashima Space Center in southwestern Japan was shown on live video by the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency, known as JAXA.

"We have a liftoff," the narrator at JAXA said as the rocket flew up in a burst of smoke then flew over the Pacific.

Thirteen minutes after the launch, the rocket put into orbit around Earth a satellite called the X-Ray Imaging and Spectroscopy Mission, or XRISM, which will measure the speed and makeup of what lies between galaxies.

That information helps in studying how celestial objects were formed, and hopefully can lead to solving the mystery of how the universe was created, JAXA says.

In cooperation with NASA, JAXA will look at the strength of light at different wavelengths, the temperature of things in space and their shapes and brightness.

David Alexander, director of the Rice Space Institute at Rice University, believes the mission is significant for delivering insight into the properties of hot



plasma, or the superheated matter that makes up much of the universe.

Plasmas have the potential to be used in various ways, including healing wounds, making computer chips and cleaning the environment.

"Understanding the distribution of this hot plasma in space and time, as well as its dynamical motion, will shed light on diverse phenomena such as black holes, the evolution of chemical elements in the universe and the formation of galactic clusters," Alexander said.

Also aboard the latest Japanese rocket is the Smart Lander for Investigating Moon, or SLIM, a lightweight lunar lander. The Smart Lander won't make lunar orbit for three or four months after the launch and would likely attempt a landing early next year, according to the space agency.

Central African Republic faces humanitarian crisis: UN

Central African Republic is facing a humanitarian crisis with 2.4 million people in need of assistance and the UN's USD 534 million appeal only 36 per cent funded, a UN official said on Wednesday.

Mohamed Ag Ayoya, deputy special representative for the UN peacekeeping mission in the country, told a news conference that 10 years of conflict have displaced half a million people within the country while 700,000 have fled to neighbouring countries.

Mineral-rich but impoverished CAR has a population of 6 million.

But Ayoya said CAR has also opened its doors to 38,000 returnees and asylum-seekers from Chad, and more recently to 18,000 returnees and asylum seekers from another neighbour, Sudan, where a conflict between rival generals and their supporters is now in its fifth month.

Ayoya stressed that CAR "is not just a humanitarian crisis, it's also actually a protection and a gender crisis".

# पूर्व डिप्टी गवर्नर विरल आचार्य ने अपनी पुस्तक में किया बड़ा दावा 2019 के चुनावों से पहले आरबीआई से तीन लाख करोड़ निकालना चाहती थी सरकार

भारतीय रिजर्व बैंक (आरबीआई) के पूर्व डिप्टी गवर्नर विरल आचार्य ने कहा है कि वर्ष 2018 में सरकार में बैठे कुछ लोगों ने चुनाव से पहले 'लोकलुभावन' खर्चों के लिए केंद्रीय बैंक से दो-तीन लाख करोड़ रुपये हासिल करने के लिए उसपर 'धावा' बोलने की कोशिश की थी जिसका पुरजोर विरोध हुआ था।

आचार्य ने अपनी किताब में लिखा है कि 2019 के आम चुनावों से पहले सरकार अपने लोकलुभावन खर्चों की भरपाई के लिए आरबीआई से यह बड़ी रकम निकालने की कोशिश में थी। लेकिन आरबीआई इसके पक्ष में नहीं था जिसकी वजह से सरकार के साथ उसके मतभेद बढ़ गए थे। उस समय सरकार ने आरबीआई को निर्देश देने के लिए भारतीय रिजर्व बैंक (आरबीआई) अधिनियम की धारा सात का इस्तेमाल करने की भी चेतावनी दी थी।

## राजकोषीय घाटे का पिछले दरवाजे से मौदीकरण

आरबीआई के तत्कालीन डिप्टी गवर्नर आचार्य ने यह मामला सबसे पहले 26 अक्टूबर, 2018 को एक पब्लिशिंग में उठाया था। अब यह प्रकरण उनकी किताब 'वेस्ट फॉर रिस्टोरिंग फाइनेंशियल स्टैबिलिटी इन इंडिया' की नई प्रस्तावना में भी प्रमुखता से उजागर हुआ है। इसमें सरकार की कोशिश को 'केंद्र द्वारा राजकोषीय घाटे का पिछले दरवाजे से मौदीकरण' बताया गया है।



## आरबीआई लाभों का एक हिस्सा अपने पास रखता है

आचार्य ने वर्ष 2020 में पहली बार प्रकाशित अपनी किताब के नए संस्करण की प्रस्तावना में कहा, लोकशाही और सरकार में बैठे रचनात्मक नस्तिधर्क वाले कुछ लोगों ने पिछली सरकारों के कार्यकाल में आरबीआई के पास जमा हुई बड़ी रकम को वर्तमान सरकार के खाते में स्थानांतरित करने की एक योजना तैयार की थी। दरअसल, आरबीआई हर साल अपना लाभ सरकार को पूरी तरह देने के बजाय उसका एक हिस्सा अलग रख देता है। यही हिस्सा कई वर्षों में एक बड़ी राशि में तब्दील हो चुका था।



सरकार की मंशा पर कसा तंत्र - अख्तियार में अपने विनिवेश लक्ष्य से बचने के बाद सरकार का राजकोषीय घाटा बढ़ गया था। उन्होंने सरकार को मंशा पर तंत्र करने हुए कहा, जब केंद्रीय बैंक के खर्चों पर धावा बोला जा सकता है और बढ़ते राजकोषीय घाटे को मैदीकृत किया जा सकता है तो फिर चुनावों में लोकलुभावन खर्चों में कटौती क्यों की जाए?

लोकलुभावन खर्च के लिए केंद्रीय बैंक पर धावा बोलने की कोशिश की थी

## आरबीआई से अधिक लाभार्थ निकालने की कोशिश

आचार्य ने कहा कि 2016 की नोटबंदी से पहले के तीन वर्षों में केंद्रीय बैंक ने सरकार को रिकॉर्ड लाभ अंतरण किया था। लेकिन नोटबंदी के साल में नोटों की छपाई पर खर्च बढ़ने से केंद्र को अतिशय हस्तक्षेप करना पड़ा था। ऐसी स्थिति में सरकार ने 2019 के चुनावों से पहले अपनी मांगों को बढ़ा दिया था। आचार्य ने कहा कि आरबीआई से अधिक लाभार्थ निकालने की कोशिश एक तरह से राजकोषीय घाटे का पिछले दरवाजे से मौदीकरण था।

## जून 2019 में आचार्य ने छोड़ा पद

आचार्य ने मौदीक नीति, वित्तीय बाजार, वित्तीय स्थिरता और अनुसंधान के प्रमुख डिप्टी गवर्नर के रूप में तीन साल का कार्यकाल पूरा होने से छह महीने पहले ही जून, 2019 में पद छोड़ दिया था।
